

FUNDED RESEARCH THROUGH CANINE HEALTH FOUNDATION

In December, 2007, The Tibetan Terrier Health and Welfare Foundation partially funded two grants through the AKC/Canine Health Foundation:

Grant 846-A This is a one-year grant, which continues Gary Johnson's work on mapping the mutation that causes NCL (CCL). The TTCA has contributed significantly toward this research project through their Donor Advised Fund. (Please see the joint report from Drs. Grant 881-A This is a one-year grant which continues David Sargan's Lens Luxation research at Cambridge University. This is a particularly interesting study in that the TT is pivotal in the research not only for our breed, but for other breeds as well. Of note is the fact that Lens Luxation is one of the primary concerns of the TTCA membership in their input to the TTCA Health Committee.
